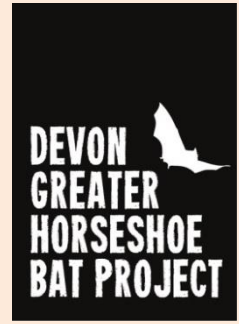

BatWorks: Landowners

Capital works scheme information



BatWorks is a capital works scheme which awards **up to £2,000** to landowners and farmers in order to help cover the costs of habitat improvements that will benefit greater horseshoe bats in their area (land owners in/around Gunnislake, Cornwall are also eligible)

Previous **Batworks** funded projects include:

- Orchard restoration work (planting and tree protection).
- Fencing and water trough installation.
- Wildflower seed purchase for creating/ enhancing a wildflower meadow.
- Greater horseshoe bat roost installation in a farm barn.

Other ideas are very welcome as long as they are directly related to helping greater horseshoe bats. We would welcome expressions of interest which include an outline of your proposed project and how it would be managed into the future.
