



To Whom It May Concern

The holder of this letter is taking part in the Devon Bat Survey as part of the Devon Greater Horseshoe Bat Project. This is a 5 year partnership project of 18 organisations led by Devon Wildlife Trust and is supported by the National Lottery Heritage Fund, as well as other funders.

Between April and October volunteers are able to borrow bat detectors to enable bats to be recorded, helping to build up a picture of how they use the landscape. Whilst our project is primarily interested in greater horseshoe bats, we will be collating information on all bat species. This information may then be used to target where we provide land management advice as part of our project.

This survey requires the volunteer to choose a 1km grid square to survey, which in this case your land lies within. They will then set up a detector in a suitable location and this is left outside to automatically trigger and record bats through the night. Detectors are normally put out in an evening and picked up the three days later, providing three nights of recordings.

Any help you can give the bearer of this letter in allowing access to privately owned land would be very much appreciated. If you do grant permission, please could you complete the form provided by the volunteer.
